We are gearing up for our 40th Anniversary of Charity, Cars, and Fun at the Frankenmuth Auto Fest. Looking back, we have enjoyed years of enjoyment and great attitudes from all our car friends and people attending our show. Our main concern is for everyone to continue to have a safe weekend.

Main Street "M-83" in Frankenmuth is a State Highway. Luckily we have had no major incidents or injury, but we have not dealt with some of the issues relating to driving golf carts & recreational vehicles on M-83. Not only is it too dangerous for golf carts to be out on Main Street with other vehicles, it is illegal for golf carts or recreational vehicles, without the proper safety equipment requirements, to be driven on a State Highway.

**Effective 9/1/23, golf carts & recreational vehicles, without the proper safety equipment requirements, will no longer be allowed to drive on Main Street "M-83".**

To drive on this road, vehicles must have headlights, taillights, turn signals, windshield, horn, seatbelts, license plates, etc. Those vehicles that do not have these requirements will be able to cross Main Street at traffic lights and legal crossover intersections, and also be able to drive down the side streets.

The Frankenmuth Police Department and their teams brought in from other departments will be patrolling the streets and enforcing these rules this year. We would appreciate your cooperation with these new rules and helping to make this a safe weekend for all.
